About GSA 8(a) STARS II

SNAP recently won a GSA 8(a) STARS II Contract, a multiple-award, indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract engineered to provide cutting-edge technology solutions from award-winning 8(a) small businesses to federal agencies. The current contract term is one five-year base period which began upon award in August 2011.

Using 8(a) STARS enables federal agencies to access 8(a) firms through an established contract vehicle instead of traditional, open market methods, saving both time and taxpayer money.

8(a) STARS is centered on four functional areas (FA) derived from the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS).



About GSA 8(a) STARS II (continued)

The contract is structured with two tiers, known as constellations, designed to provide additional benefits and more flexibility to the customer.

Constellation I includes prime contractors who are technically proficient and offer competitive pricing.

Constellation II includes prime contractors who provide the same strengths as Constellation I, plus the additional benefit of either a Capability Maturity Model Integration (CMMI) Level II or above or an ISO 9001:2000 or 9001:2008 credential.

SNAP won contracts in both Constellation I and Constellation II for all functions areas, which includes:

- 8(a) STARS II is GSA's 3rd generation 8(a) GWAC
- 8(a) STARS allows directed task orders up to \$4M
- No offer and acceptance letter is required from the Small Business Administration (SBA)
- No FedBizOpps synopsis is required
- Complimentary task order scope compatibility reviews are provided by the Small Business GWAC Center
- Task orders may be issued directly or by a 3rd party acquisition shop such as GSA's Office of Assisted Acquisition Services
